Rakiura Museum is continually endeavouring to enhance its level of service and visitor experience as well as expanding the current collection and conserving items. Established and run entirely by volunteers, the museum attracts thousands of visitors each year, relying on small door charge revenue and donations to carry out its important work of collecting and preserving historic articles from Stewart Island's past.

First opened in 1960 and run by a local Trust with dedicated volunteers, the Rakiura Museum houses over 5000 items and is of vital importance to the present and future generations of Stewart Islanders and to those whose families have links with the Island's past.
